CAMP RECEIVES CHALLENGE GRANT FROM JCAMP 180

We're so pleased to announce that Camp Interlaken has been named a recipient of the Chai Match 2 challenge grant from JCamp 180, a program of the Harold Grinspoon Foundation. Camp is eligible to receive up to \$54,000 in matching funds to renew Camp facilities and provide operating and scholarship support.

In the past eight years, JCamp 180 has contributed over \$11.7 million in matching grant funds to non-profit Jewish overnight summer camps throughout North America.

Camp Director Toni Davison Levenberg commented, "We are thankful for having been awarded this challenge grant by JCamp 180 and the Harold Grinspoon Foundation. 

Our thanks to alumni, parents and staff who have planned and prepared Camp for future generations while holding on to the special ruach (spirit) that is Interlaken.


