

Hello {RecipientGreeting},

We interrupt this week's regularly scheduled *hoda'ah* because we have received a lot of questions about Covid-19 - some of which we can't answer yet. But, we wanted to try to do our best before we talk about packing for Camp!

Camp Interlaken is working closely with our medical committee to create protocols and policies for the summer of 2022 to mitigate the risk and minimize the spread of Covid-19. We will likely roll out these policies to you in late May.

That being said, we can tell you a few quick things:

- 1. Camp Interlaken will be a fully vaccinated site this summer. All staff, campers, and guests are required to be fully vaccinated as defined by the CDC. Currently, fully vaccinated means two shots. It does not include a booster.
- 2. Vaccine cards will need to be submitted via CampMinder. You can upload those now if you have not already.
- 3. We will likely ask that everybody gets a PCR test 72 hours before Camp and submits their results via CampMinder.
- 4. This summer, we are bussing campers normally from Chicago, Milwaukee, and Madison. I am uncertain what our masking policies will be for the bus ride; we will let you know that late in May when we roll out our policies.
- 5. We will likely have some element of PCR testing at Camp this summer and will need your consent for our lab to test your camper. That link is in your forms dashboard on CampMinder for you to fill out now.
- 6. Our <u>packing list</u> includes a box of disposable masks. We don't know yet what our masking policy will be, but we know it's better to have it now and remove it later than the other way around.

As always, our first priority is the health and safety of each member of our community. We will share 2022's Covid-19 Playbook towards the end of May. We are really looking forward to an amazing summer that can't come soon enough!
