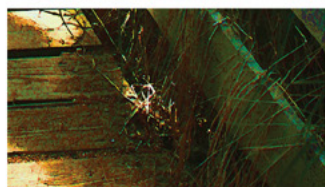
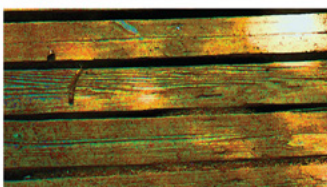
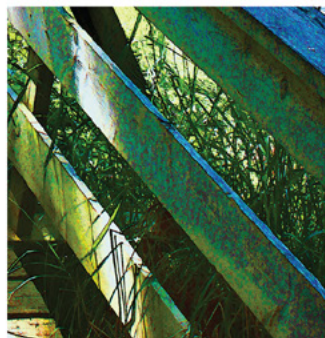
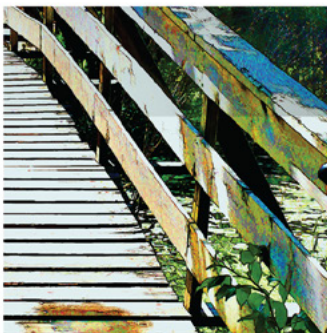
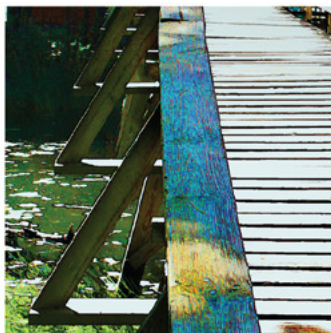
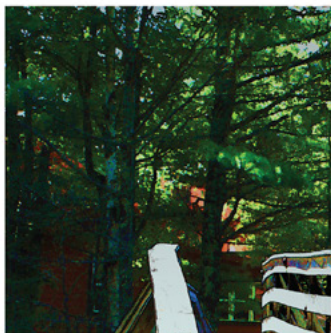
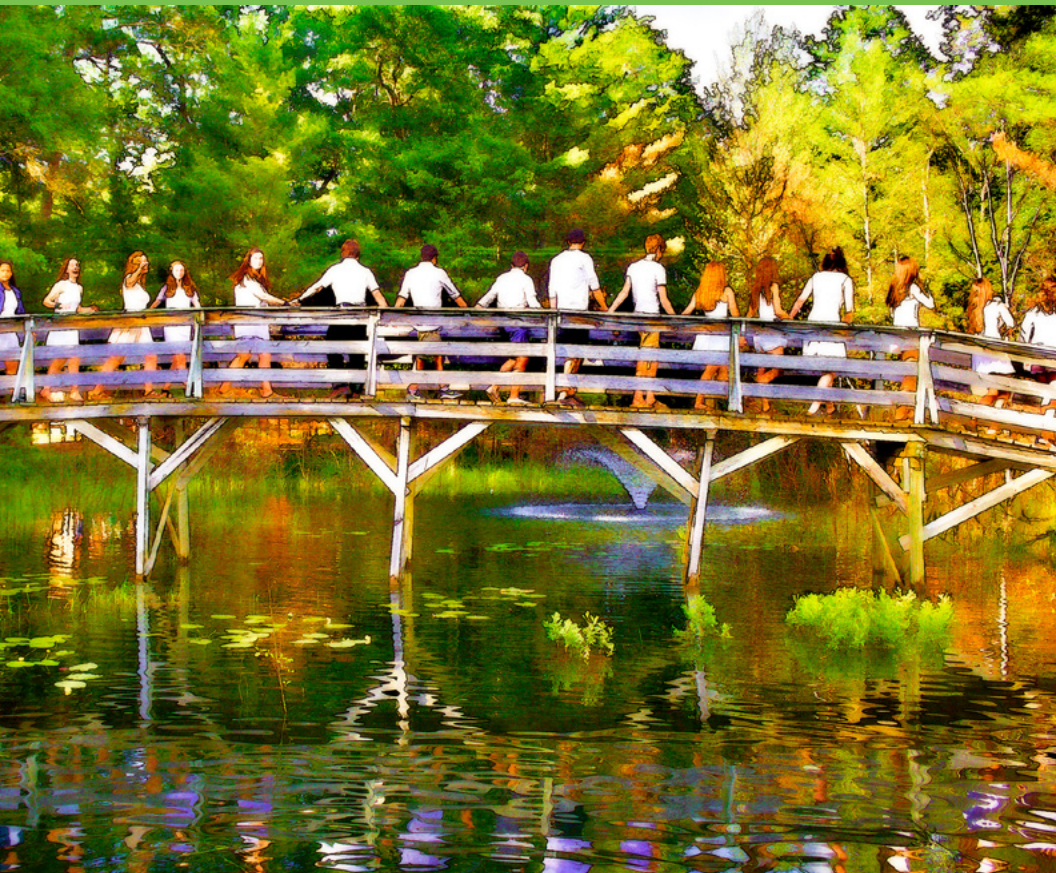


BRIDGE TO THE FUTURE

1-YEAR GOAL

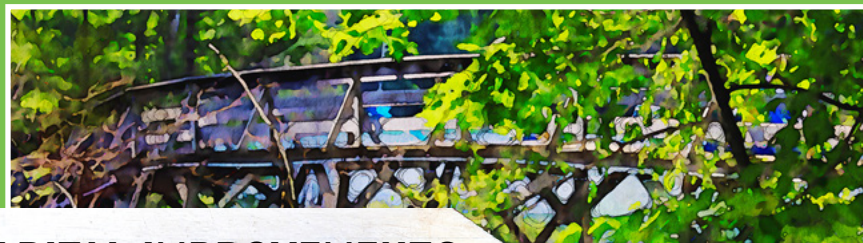
Raise \$300,000 in scholarship funds that can be put to immediate use over the coming years to ensure Camp is an option for everyone.

10-YEAR GOAL

Endow an additional \$1 million to provide annual scholarship aid in perpetuity.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

Camp's magic lives in the people and the traditions, but camp's success is contingent upon updated and well-maintained facilities. Without adequate space to share family dinner and Shabbat with friends, appropriate facilities to plan "heavy dew" programming, or suitable housing for high-caliber staff, it will become increasingly challenging for Camp Interlaken to continue providing exceptional camp experiences.

1-YEAR GOAL

Raise \$1.4 million to build a new Chadar Ochel (Dining Hall), the centerpiece of Camp's daily life, with the support of a matching grant opportunity.

10-YEAR GOAL

Secure Camp's future by:

Constructing a "Heavy Dew" indoor space for sports and programs (\$1.5 million)

Refurbishing staff housing to support our high-caliber team (\$1 million)

Rebuilding our iconic Bridge to carry Camp's traditions forward (\$300k)

When we invest in Camp's spaces, we invest in its soul and in the future of every camper who calls Interlaken home.

At Camp Interlaken, every program — from Tushball to sailing on Lake Finley — is a chance for campers to discover new passions, build confidence, and grow into their best selves.

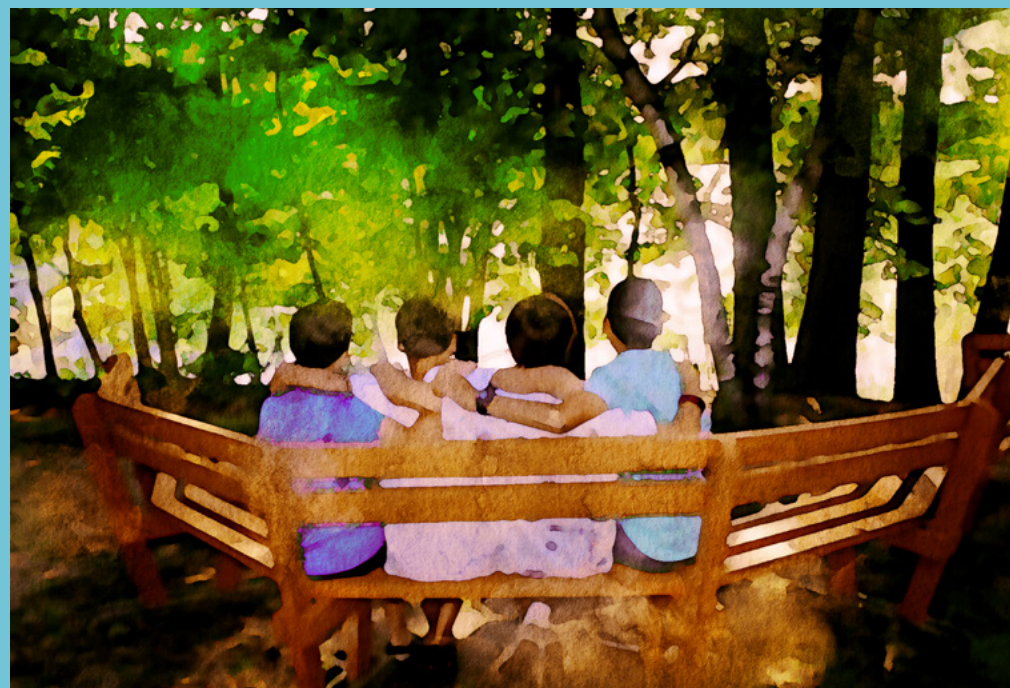
